**NATIONAL CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION**

The Department of Political Science, Salipur Autonomous College, Salipur organized CONSTITUTION DAY (SAMBIDHAN DIVAS) on Nov 26<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 11:00AM in the career counseling Hall of the college. This was conducted as instructed by the U.G.C vide its circular dtd 15<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

The objective of the program is to inculcate constitutional obligations among students, to create awareness about constitution & to sensitize the students about the importance of constitution day. The decorated portrait of the preamble of Indian constitution was displayed.

The meeting was presided over by Prof. Tushar Kumar Mohanty, HOD, Political science. The chief Guest for this occasion was Dr. Sangita Misra (Principal, Salipur Autonomous College, Salipur) and Guest of Honor was Dr. Prasanna Kumar Mohapatra (Administrative Bursar). A total of 92 students and 10 members of the staff participated on the occasion.

The celebration started with the lighting of the lamp by the Chief Guest and Guest of Honor. The Chief Guest and Guest of Honor were also felicitated by the Department of Political Science with a memento as a token of appreciation. The Head of the Department welcomed all. In his speech, HOD of Political Science Prof. Tushar Kumar Mohanty had highlighted the significance of the day and on the theme of “INDIA: THE MOTHER OF DEMOCRACY” and encouraged the students to abide by the constitution.

  - d) Fundamental Duties pasted in the Notice Board.

The Chief Guest Dr. Sangita Misra (Principal, Salipur Autonomous College, Salipur) read the preamble of the Indian constitution and Fundamental Duties of the Indian citizens and helped the staffs and students to repeat it. The Chief Guest delivered on the guiding principles of the Indian constitution, the importance of the constitution day and commemorated the people who contributed to the development of Indian constitution. The Guest of Honor Dr. Prasanna Kumar Mohapatra (Administrative Bursar) highlighted on the Fundamental Rights and Fundamental Duties of Indian citizens.
